## RELAX IN STYLE

In 1955 while filming on location, director Billy Wilder discovered he could take quick naps on a plank held up by sawhorses. This prompted Wilder to tell his friends Charles and Ray Eames that he needed a narrow office couch. The Eameses remembered that conversation and in 1968 introduced the Eames chaise, giving the first one to Wilder. It's soft, comfortable, and just 18 inches wide. When you lie on it, you naturally fold your arms over your chest. Should you doze off, your arms soon fall to your sides, waking you up. That way, you won't get caught napping.

### SLEEK SOPHISTICATION

With its thin lines, black leather, and sculptural frame and base, the chaise is a contemporary work of art.

### CUSHIONED COMFORT

Six 2½-inch-thick foam cushions are upholstered in soft leather. Joined by flexible zippers, the cushions are secured to nylon fabric tightly slung on the frame. Two loose cushions give additional support for the neck, back, or legs. The gently curved frame puts the body in a healthful relaxed position, with the head and legs slightly raised.

### SECURE SUPPORT

The die-cast aluminum frame and base are stable and strong. A scratch-resistant, eggplant-colored nylon coating is electrostatically applied to the aluminum. Glides are high-impact nylon.
