DRAMA AND UTILITY TAKE SHAPE

With its long, low shape, this elliptical table reminds some of a surfboard—a shape familiar to Charles and Ray Eames, who enjoyed commanding views of the Pacific Ocean from their home and studio. In 1951, having perfected a manufacturing technique for welding wire-rod bases, they decided to bridge two bases with a dramatically shaped top large enough to hold a variety of items and fit comfortably in front of a long sofa or several chairs. Finished in either black or white laminate, the table is a striking addition to waiting rooms, reception areas, executive lounges, and homes—from landlocked to beachfront.

AN EXPANSIVE ARC

The elliptical table's surface provides a sea of room to spread out. The tabletop consists of a seven-ply Baltic birch core sandwiched between high-pressure laminate (in black or white).

AN ATTRACTIVE ANGLE

The Eameses beveled the table's edge on a 20-degree angle to give the top more emphasis.
