

ADJUSTING THE ERGON 3 CHAIR

Active adjustments give people control over their own comfort and support.

1. Seat height — The A size adjusts pneumatically from 15½ to 20½ inches; B size, 16 to 20¾ inches; C size, 16 to 21 inches.
2. Back angle — The backrest can be locked anywhere in a 10-degree range for an open angle between the upper and lower body, maintaining the spine's natural curve.
3. Armrest height and angle — Each arm adjusts independently in a 4-inch range; the ¼-inch width adjustment further refines the fit. Armrests angle inward and outward in a 25-degree range for keyboarding and mousing.
4. Back height — The sitter can adjust the backrest in a 6-position, 3-inch range for proper lower back support.
5. Tilt lock—The standard knee tilt includes a lock to keep the chair in an upright position. An optional tilt lock secures the chair at a 5-degree forward seat angle or in an upright position.
6. Tilt tension—This controls the amount of resistance felt when leaning back.

THE JOY OF SITTING

The Ergon 3 chair looks as comfortable as it feels. With deep, inviting contours, the foam cushions create a natural pocket that supports the body and aligns it to the work at hand. Soft edges and a waterfall seat front are gentle on arms and legs, helping to maintain proper circulation however long a person sits. This cushioned comfort is especially important for those who spend a significant part of their days doing computer-related work.



THE CONSTANT IS COMFORT

The chair that made history in 1976 by introducing research-based ergonomic comfort to office seating is now in its third generation. For Ergon 3 chairs, designer Bill Stumpf updated the line with new sizes and capabilities to fit nearly everyone and support nearly every task. At the same time, he preserved elements of the original—the plush, cushioned comfort, the look of essential ergonomic design. Amid all the office chairs on the market today, the Ergon 3 chair remains a wise choice for work, relaxation, and whatever else the day may bring.

The Ergon 3 work chair comes in three sizes—A, B, and C—to fit small, medium, and large people. All three sizes offer the same features and adjustments, giving 5th percentile women to 95th percentile men the same high level of performance.
