Limerick chairs are right up there. They stack 10 high on the floor or 36 high on the specially designed cart. Fortunately, their price is down to earth and their design well grounded in comfort. Designer Tom Newhouse gave Limerick a flexible back that provides lumbar support and subtle movement, and he made its seat wider and back higher than most comparable chairs. He also designed an open sled base with no braces to get in the way of tucked feet. And he made Limerick lightweight, so it can stack high, link together in neat rows, or move quickly into place to give guests a comfortable seat during impromptu meetings.
